VII. MEETING REPORT

18.05.2017

The seventh student senate meeting was held on Thursday, May 18, 2017, at 15:00 in the Student Dean's meeting room with the Sakarya University Student Dean (Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ahmet Özmen), Student Dean's Secretary (Mustafa Kemal KÖSE), and senate member students. The following topics were discussed/exchanged views:

- Student Dean Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ahmet ÖZMEN provided information about the "Foreign Language Measurement and Evaluation System" to be implemented in the new term.
- Answering the senate members' questions, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ahmet ÖZMEN stated that the application would be valid for students entering in 2017, and students who entered in 2016 and earlier would not be affected by the prepared application.
- Student Senate Member Yasin USTA noted that giving a letter grade instead of the "MU" grade would be more positive for students. He also said that since the issue is new, this information being shared is important for announcing it to other students.
- Student Senate Member Fatih SERT stated that 10 courses were opened in the summer school at the law faculty, but most of these courses could not be taken due to conflicts, which would cause semester extension. He also requested that course conflicts be ignored by the system for students who take the course during the semester and meet the attendance requirement. Additionally, he mentioned that the law faculty parking lot being gravel causes damage to vehicles and does not leave a good impression on guests.
- Student Senate Member Yasin GÜL stated that no courses could be opened in the summer school in the Turkish Language and Literature department due to the department head not approving, and requested from the student dean's office to ensure course opening as enough signatures were collected. He also noted that there is excessive deterioration at the entrance of the Arts and Sciences (D) block and a renovation need exists.
- Student Senate Member Sinem TOÇOĞLU, thanking for being part of such a formation as she will graduate this year, mentioned that there are renovation works for the athletics track at the Sports Sciences Faculty, and it would be better for future students if athletics instructors' opinions are taken to create a more suitable track. She also explained the difficulties due to the lack of a canteen in the faculty.
